For each of the BFI Ten Steps that meets the target, the facility receives a quality improvement status.

Bronze status - Facility has met requirements of 3 to 5 of the 10 steps

Silver status - Facility has met requirements of 6 to 8 of the 10 steps

Gold status - Facility has met requirements of 9 of the 10 steps

Platinum status – Facility has met requirements of 10 of the 10 steps and is eligible to move to BFI External Assessment.
